A festival is an occasion of enjoyment and celebration which promotes a child's social interaction and harmony.



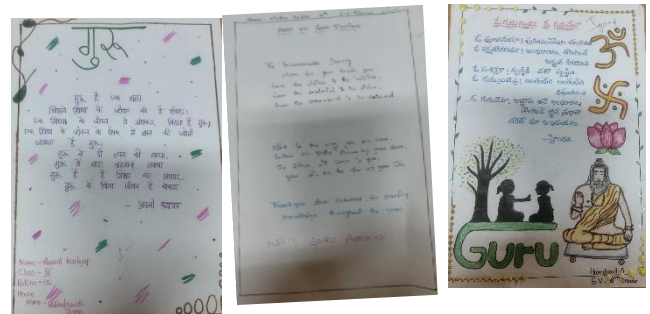
EXPRESSIONS THROUGH EMOJIS
