Welcome Back To School.....



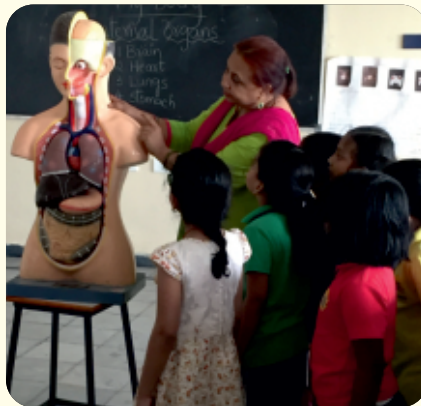
