Class VIII To X Activities

At T.I.M.E. learning doesn't happen by chance. Rather, it is a time-bound product envisioned and planned for by our teachers. Here are some activities that throw light on this process:

Class VIII to X: English

- Students of class IX B presented a role play on Pygmalion.



- Students of class IX coined stories in group and then reviewed the stories of other groups.



- Students of class IX participated in a Group Discussion deliberating on the topic: Social Media sites kill creativity. This activity also acted as a prelude to the nomination of students for the School Council Election – Vice Category.
- Students of class X similarly had a Group Discussion on the topic: Global warming does not lead to melting of polar ice caps alone. Based on their performance in this discussion, students were nominated for the School Council Election – Captain Category.
- Class X students are in the process of presenting their findings on Leonardo Da Vinci’s works commemorating the 500th anniversary of the renowned painter’s death.
- Class IX students spoke of the most frightening incident in their life as a text-related speaking activity.
- Class X students were divided into 3 groups and each group presented a part of Chapter 7: Glimpses of India in a peculiar presentation mode. The presenting was asked to present their part only through answers to questions raised by the other 2 groups in the audience. To facilitate this the presenting group had to bring charts or other props. All the groups had to read all the parts in order to be able to question the presenting group. This collaborative learning process was enjoyed and appreciated by the students.



- Class IX students completed a group activity wherein they combined the results of a survey with their own opinions on any of the two topics: Getting a Good Job is More Important than Being a Good Human Being / Career Building is the only Goal of Education.

Class VIII to X: Science

- Students of class X completed a lab activity on Acids, Bases and Salts.
- Students of class IX and X had created mind maps and flow charts for the chapters in Biology.
- Students of class VIII explained the importance of adaptation and how animals are able to survive.

Class VIII: Telugu

- Group Activity on House List was done by the students of class VIII A. Vedamayi's caption was noteworthy.
