The Triumph Of The Moon

The Indian Space Research Organisation's (ISRO) third lunar mission Chandrayaan-3, launched on July 14, made a successful landing on the Moon's surface on August 23. It is a follow-up of Chandrayaan-2 which failed to make a soft landing and crashed during touchdown. The main objectives of Chandrayaan 3 was soft and safe landing on the surface of the moon and conduct on-site experiments on the lunar surface. So far, only three countries, the U.S., Russia, and China have successfully soft-landed on the moon. After a successful landing on the moon, India became the fourth country to achieve a soft landing on the Moon and the first country to land near moon's south pole. It represents a remarkable step forward for India's space program and showcases the nation's dedication to space exploration and discovery. Precisely at 6.03 p.m. after a nail-biting wait, ISRO confirmed that Chandrayaan-3's lander had successfully touched down in the Moon's southern polar region as planned and there was euphoric celebrations at the ISRO command center. Congratulations to all the Indians and ISRO team. I feel extremely proud of this achievement made by P. Veeramuthvel, project director of Chandrayaan-3 mission along with his colleagues. I hope to see many more great achievements be made by India in the coming years. The successes of Chandrayaan 3 on the Moon showcase the boundless possibilities of human exploration.

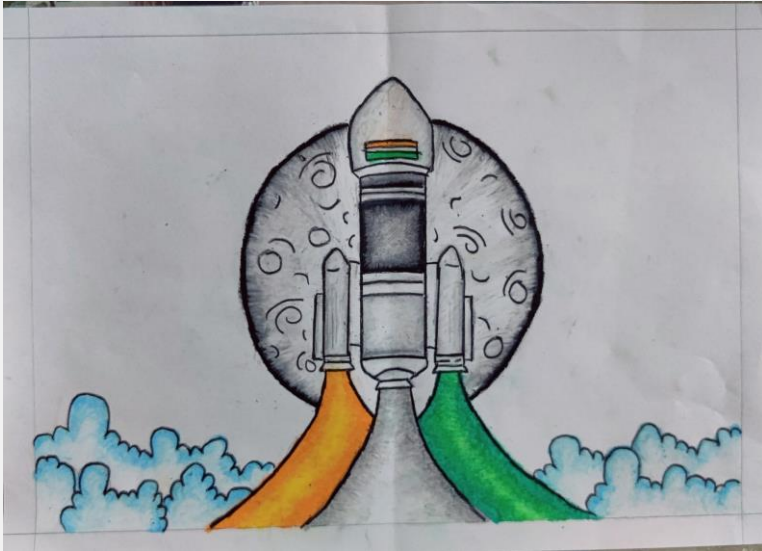

Report on Chandrayaan-3

After an unexpected failure of the mission Chandrayaan 2 on September 7th, 2019, ISRO had realised their mistakes and the problems faced while landing,



and started working on them from the very next day of the failure of Chandrayaan 2. They didn't lose hope at all and came up with a new mission named Chandrayaan 3. It was launched on July 14th, 2023. This time ISRO was very confident about this mission. ISRO used less powerful rockets and followed the slingshot method which is very budget efficient. Finally, after a journey of 40 days into the space, on August 23, 2023 at 6:02, the Vikram lander lands on the surface of the moon and by this India becomes the first ever country to land on the South pole of the moon, which is a very proud moment for India. I personally celebrated the success of this mission.

Blue Day Celebration

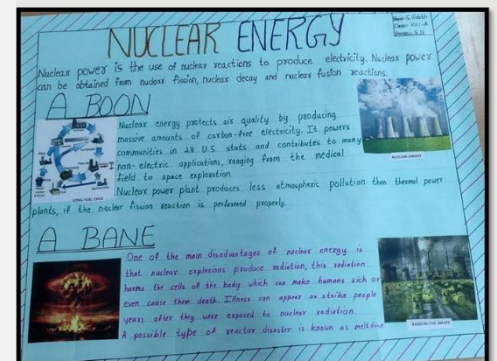
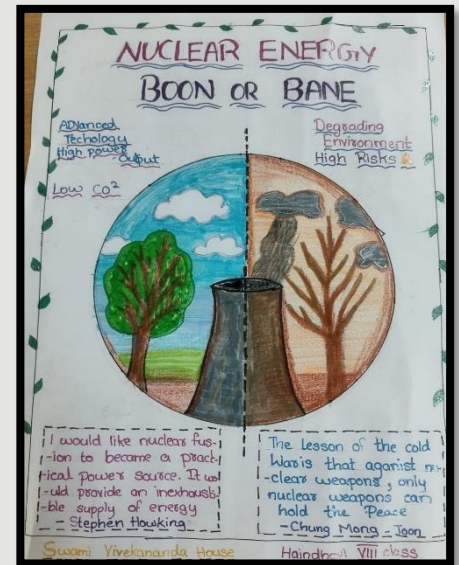
The children of Pre-primary wore bright and wonderful shades of blue to celebrate Blue Day on 18th of August. Various activities were conducted with colour Blue as theme.
