I wish you all the very best for the rest of the academic year.

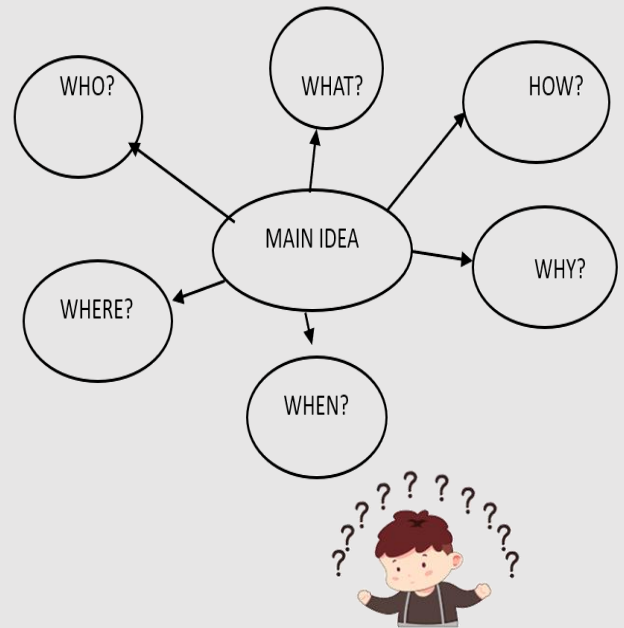

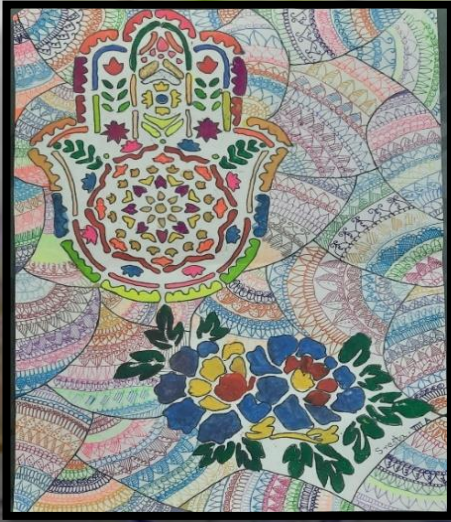


IIT Vigyantram Workshop :
