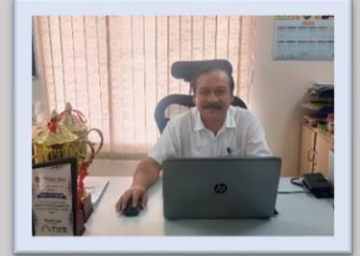

Taekwondo, also spelt tae kwon do or taekwondo is a Korean martial art and combat sport involving punching and kicking techniques. The literal translation for taekwondo is "kicking", "punching", and "the art or way of". It sometimes involves the use of weapons. The art of self-defense originated in Korea. It is recognized as one of the oldest forms of martial arts in the world, reaching back over 2,000 years. The name was selected for its appropriate description of the art: Tae (foot), Kwon (hand), and Do (art). Modern Taekwondo started to emerge in the late 1940s with the liberation of Korea from the Japanese occupation. When Korea was liberated, the Masters began teaching their arts openly again.

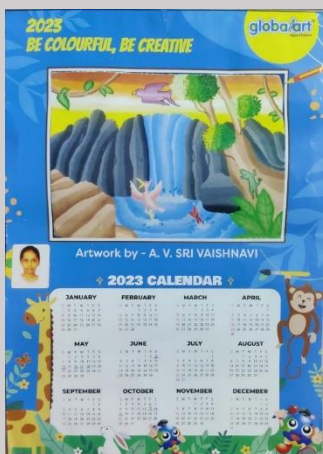

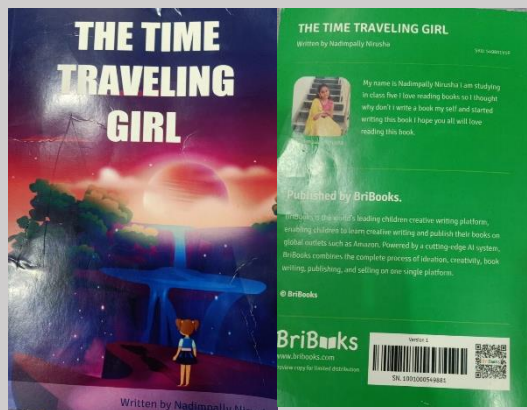
